Zion Episcopal Church

built in 1834

1833 - Church was organized. Among the early vestrymen were Washington Irving, and James & Alexander Hamilton, Jr., sons of Alexander Hamilton, the first U.S. Secretary of the Treasury.

1853 & 1870 - The church building was enlarged.

1922 - A bell was added to the church steeple commemorating those who served in the armed forces in World War I.

1977 - Zion was the site of the ordination of Barbara Schlachter, one of the first women to be ordained priest in the Episcopal Church.
